Victoria could not be in attendance as she was traveling up North after receiving word of the passing of her sister in law. However, Victoria did ask her aunt Fidelia Haiyupis and cousin Ernie Smith to speak on her behalf and to relay the message that she accepts the apology.

Mr Rennalls arrived in Ehattesaht the evening of May 15 and was greeted with a warm welcome from a Youth Center
